About the Project

This project is the first joint venture between the Habitat for Humanity of Greater Plainfield and Middlesex County and the Perth Amboy Redevelopment Team for Neighborhood Enterprise (PARTNER).

We are proud to dedicate this Home For A Hero new construction to a veteran. The home includes 3 bedrooms, one and a half bathrooms, and a one car garage. Green or reusable building materials will be used where possible, and the house will be ENERGY STAR certified for energy efficiency.

Total Estimated Project Cost:

\$250,000

Family Selection:

Perth Amboy Housing Authority will provide a list of qualified veterans with DD 214 status. Homeowners must contribute 200-400 hours of “sweat equity”, working side-by-side with volunteers on constructing their home.

Estimated Sale Price to homeowner:

\$150-175,000

VOLUNTEER

As a volunteer for the Home For A Hero Build Project, there is always a place for you to bring your unique talents and skills. Building experience is not necessary to volunteer with us as our staff and key volunteers will provide you with all the training needed. And, our partner family works alongside our volunteers while they are earning “sweat equity,” so it’s a great way to meet future Habitat homeowners.

In addition to the approximately 4,000+ visits of skilled and non-skilled volunteers, we also need twenty-five to thirty volunteers skilled in the construction trade. Skilled volunteers are needed to supervise and train the volunteers under the direction of the Habitat construction supervisor.

Construction Support:

Being on the construction site is a rewarding experience. While volunteers building on site must be at least 16 years old, we offer non-building programs for all ages that support our construction efforts.
