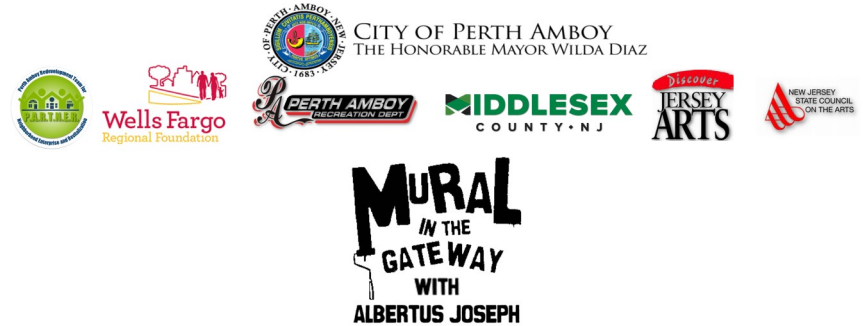

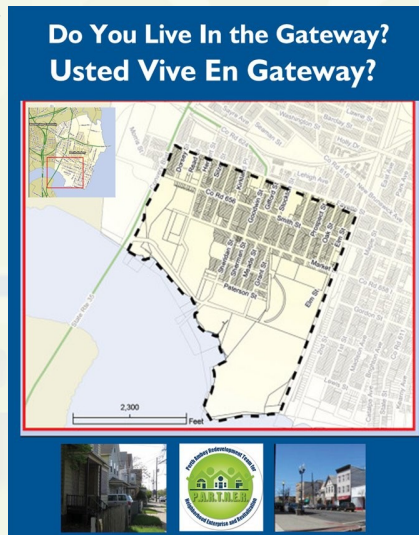
## About Gateway Neighborhood Collaborative
