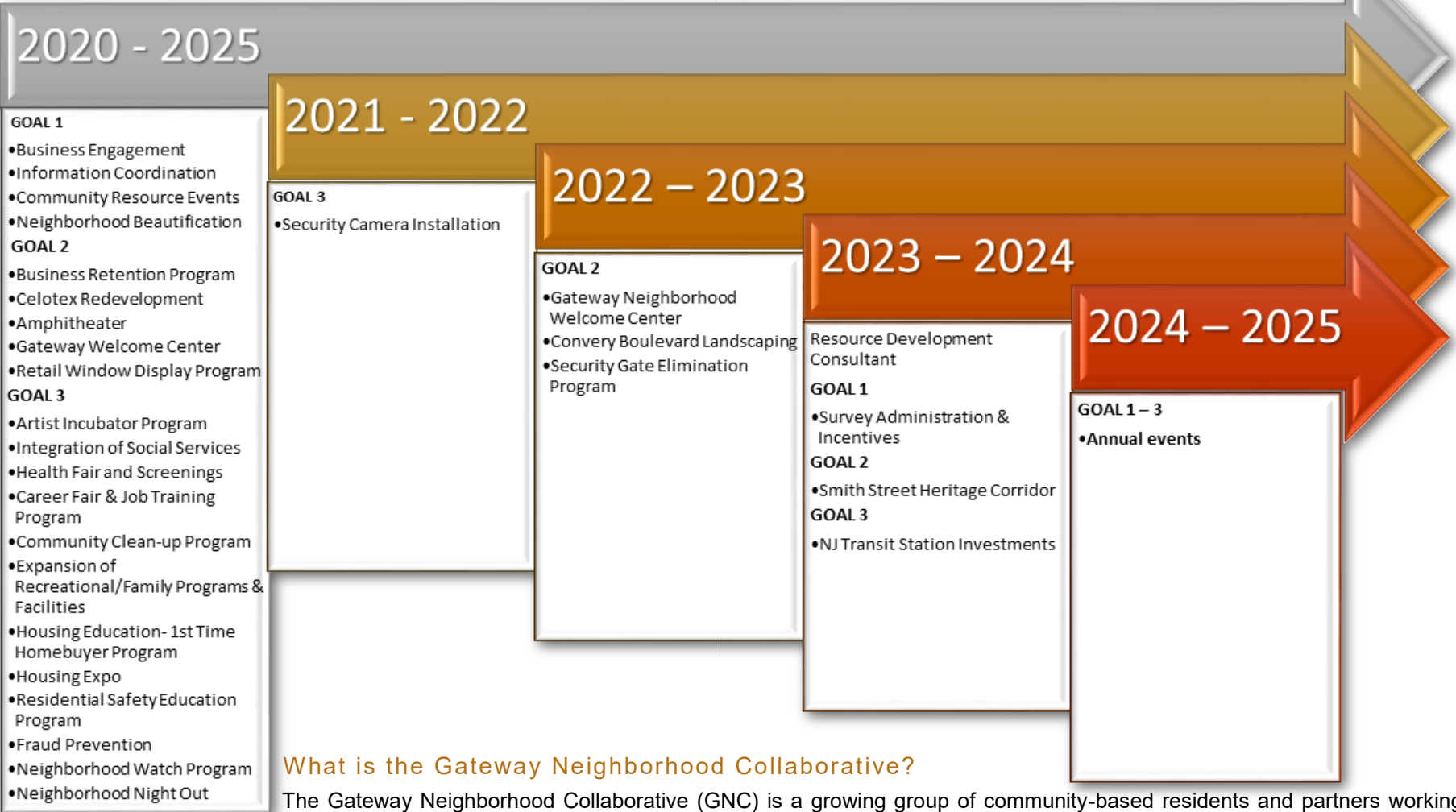

**What is the Gateway Neighborhood Collaborative?**
